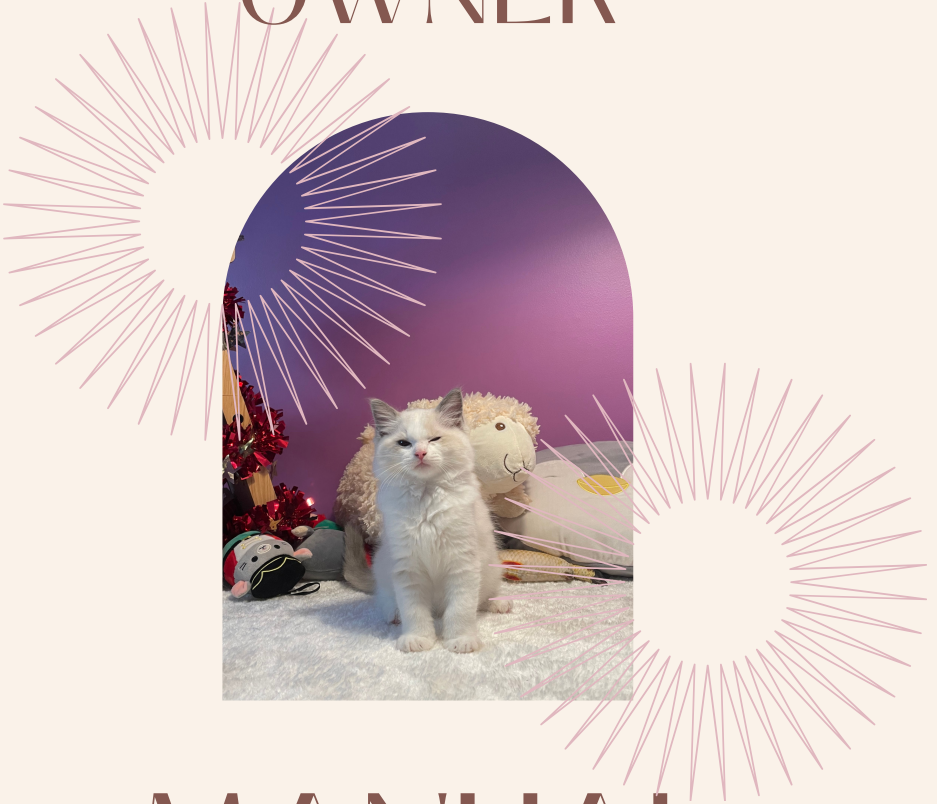

1. A water fountain: A cat water fountain is great because it helps your cat drink more water, keeps the water fresh and clean, stops germs from growing, taps into your cat's love for running water.

2. Cat tree: A cat tree is awesome because it gives your cat a fun place to play, climb, and scratch, which keeps them active and happy. It also offers them a cozy spot to nap and a high perch to check out everything, which is something cats love. Plus, it helps save your furniture from getting scratched up!





3. Toys: they keep your cat entertained, help them stay active, encourage their natural hunting instincts, and can even reduce boredom-related behavior issues. Plus, playing together can strengthen the bond between you and your cat.

4. Cat litter & litter box: litter is crucial because it provides your cat with a comfortable, absorbent place to go to the bathroom, helps control odors, makes cleaning up after your cat much easier, and supports good hygiene by containing waste and minimizing bacterial spread.

MY KITTEN IS NOT DRINKING OR EATING

It's not uncommon for kittens to take some time to adjust to a new environment, especially during their first day in a new home. Here are some tips to help encourage your kitten to eat and drink:

1. **Provide a quiet space:** create a quiet and safe space for your kitten to explore and feel comfortable in
2. **Offer familiar food:** use the same food that the kitten was eating before coming to your home (the food package we provided)
3. **Interactive play:** Engage your kitten in interactive play sessions to stimulate their appetite and encourage them to be active (same time can be used as a way to create relationship bonds.
4. **Monitor closely:** Keep an eye on your kitten's behavior and monitor their eating and drinking habits. If you notice any signs of illness or continued refusal to eat or drink, consult your veterinarian and reach out to us.





CAN I SWITCH TO A DIFFERENT FOOD IMMEDIATELY WHEN I PICK UP THE KITTEN ?

We strongly discourage parents from switching a kitten's food immediately upon picking them up or bringing them home. Abrupt changes in diet can upset their stomach and lead to digestive issues such as diarrhea or vomiting. Kittens, like many animals, need time to adjust to new foods gradually.

CAN I BATH THE KITTEN IF IT IS DIRTY ?

Bathing a kitten during its first week at home should generally be avoided unless necessary. The first week in a new home is already a significant adjustment period for them, so adding the stress of a bath may not be ideal. So from the recommendation section above, we encourage parents to by dry shampoo because it will come very handy for the first one to three months. Kittens are usually quite good at grooming themselves, especially when they are healthy. Therefore, they typically don't require baths.





CAN I PLAY IMMEDIATELY WITH MY KITTEN WHEN HE GETS PICKED UP ?

Let the kitten come to you !! The first day or two after being picked up can be overwhelming for a kitten, as they are in a new place with new sights, sounds, and smells. Be patient and let your kitten set the pace for interaction and play.

WHEN SHOULD I BOOK A VET APPOINTMENT ?

It's recommended to schedule a vet appointment shortly after bringing your kitten home, ideally within the first week. This allows the vet to perform a thorough examination. Your vet will provide a schedule for the next round of vaccinations and preventive care tailored to your kitten's age and health status. Regular check-ups and vaccinations are crucial to protect your kitten from common diseases and ensure it grows and develops properly.





HOW CAN I INTRODUCE THE NEW KITTEN TO MY CURRENT EXISTING CAT ?

Introducing a new cat to an existing cat in your household requires patience, careful planning, and gradual steps to ensure a smooth transition and minimize stress for both cats.

1. **Prepare a separate space:** Set up a separate room for the new cat with all necessities.
2. **Initial separation:** Keep them separated at first to let them adjust to each other's scents.
3. **Gradual introductions:** Swap bedding, feed near the door, and allow visual access.
4. **Supervised meetings:** Open the door for short, supervised face-to-face meetings.
5. **Positive reinforcement:** Use treats and toys to encourage calm interactions.
6. **Gradual integration:** Increase supervised interaction time and space exploration.
7. **Patience and consistency:** Be patient, avoid rushing, and seek professional help if needed.





CAN I BRING THE KITTEN OUTSIDE ?

- 1.Ensure your kitten is vaccinated and protected against fleas and ticks.
- 2.Always supervise your kitten outdoors to keep them safe.
- 3.Use a secure harness and leash for walks and exploration.
- 4.Avoid busy or hazardous areas and extreme weather conditions.
- 5.Check your kitten for dirt or injuries after outdoor outings.
- 6.Start with short outdoor sessions and gradually increase time as they get used to it.
- 7.Schedule regular vet check-ups for overall health monitoring.

WHEN SHOULD I PREPARE THE ESSENTIALS FOR THE KITTEN?

You should prepare the essentials for your kitten before bringing them home. This ensures that they have everything they need for a smooth transition and a comfortable environment. Ideally, start preparing the essentials a few days to a week before the kitten's arrival. This gives you enough time to gather necessary items and set up their space properly.
